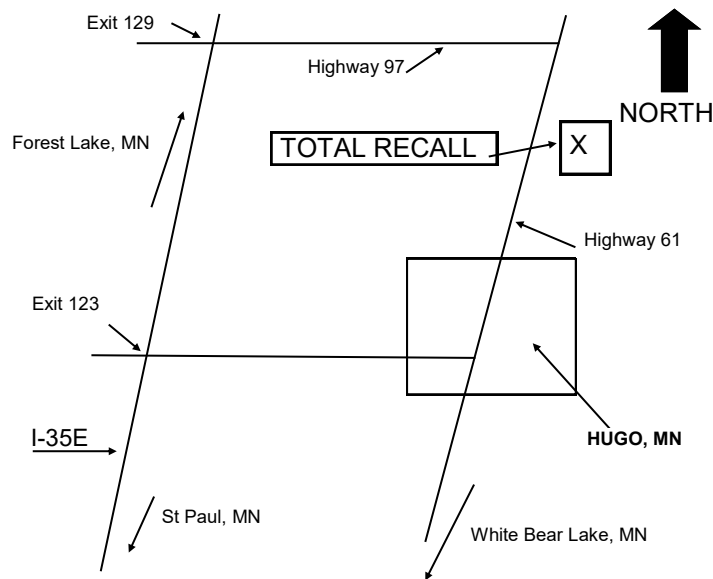

Bred by Exhibitor Class Eligibility

Due to a rule change, effective September 2002, the AKC has asked that the following items be included in all conformation Premium Lists.

- All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at select dog shows across the country. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show. Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best Of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/ Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible winner.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety. The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.

AWARDS OF MERIT

Judge's Select Awards (Awards of Merit) will be presented after the Best of Breed competition, at the discretion of the judge, in no particular order and in any quantity per gender up to two awards. Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winners are excluded from the selection

VETERAN CLASS

For Dogs and Bitches seven (7) years or older. Winners of these classes are eligible for Best of Breed Competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Non-regular Classes involving multiple dog entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entries will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won their classes.

STUD DOG CLASS

For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. While the Stud Dog need not be entered in any other Regular or Non-Regular Class, he must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with his Get. Only the Get will be judged. Each dog entered as a Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some Non-Regular Class other than Stud Dog. There is no additional fee to the Get for the Stud Dog Class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS

For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. While the Brood Bitch need not be entered in any other Regular or Non-Regular Class, she must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with her Produce. Only the Produce will be judged. Each dog entered as a Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some Non-Regular Class other than Brood Bitch. There is no additional fee to the Produce for the Brood Bitch Class.

BRACE CLASS

The quality of the dogs, their similarity and their ability to be shown together are of primary consideration. An examination of each dog is necessary to determine quality, similarity, and if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy of the breed standard. All braces must be moved to determine their ability to show together. Although dogs need not be identical, the final determination should be based on their overall similarity and uniformity standing and moving.

The person accompanying the dog to the show must show this identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at 320-963-7705.

Make checks/money orders payable to Cindy O'Hare, DSBD. Please mail checks/money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Canadian Exhibitors** make fees payable in **U.S. Funds**.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, excused, disqualified by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it impossible to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whomever shall make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.

No refund of duplicate entries.

Consult judging program for time of judging.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/agents are responsible for having their dogs in the judging rings when classes are called. The Show-giving Club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling/locating dogs.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates unless they are being judged or in the exercise ring.

Bitches in season (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete . . . American Kennel Club *Obedience Regulation*, amended to November 11, 2013. If a bitch, entered in this show, is proven to be in season on the date of the show . . . a refund of the entry fee less \$10.00 per entry will be made by the show giving club to the owner of the bitch.
