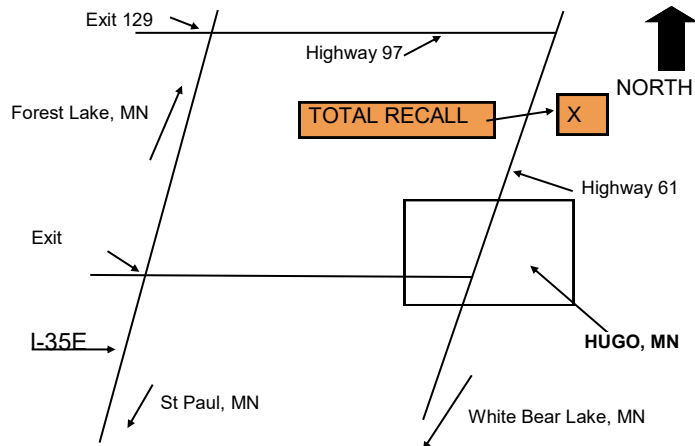

## **SITE & Ring Procedures—for COVID-19 Compliance.**

**General procedures for both Obedience and Rally.** Handlers will check themselves in and pull their armbands and rubber bands. Judges will not hand out placement ribbons, you'll have to pick up your own, just like agility.

### **Obedience:**

**Novice**—no posts for figure 8, big cones instead. Leash can be placed in a tote held by steward who will put it on the “go get it” chair. Stays will be the same as regulation. Judge will sanitize between dogs, (this is due to the requirement that the judge touch the dog on the stand/stay ex.)

**Open**—Figure 8 the same as Novice. Handler will leave their Dumbbell on a chair just outside the ring and recover it themselves. Stewards changing jumps will be assigned to a jump for the entire class and will sanitize before and after each class. Handler will deposit their leash on the “go get it chair” and later will go get it. Steward will then wipe each leash chair. Handler will pick up DB on the way out of the ring.

**Utility**—For articles, we will use a plastic container. Handler will place articles in the tub with gloves on top prior to entering the ring. Glove steward will use tongs or rubber gloves to handle gloves, (there will be a lot of tong use in this class). If gloves are used by Steward, Steward will sanitize between exhibitors. Article Steward will select the in use articles and place them on the in ring chair using tongs. When the article ex comes up, article Steward will place the pile using tongs. Judge will take the article on the clipboard, as usual and place in the pile. After the ex is completed, article Steward will recover the articles with tongs or gloves. Judge will sanitize between dogs for the moving stand ex. As with Open, Stewards will be assigned jumps to change

### **Rally:**

Walk throughs will be limited in both number and time. Details to be determined by entry. Exhibitors, please practice doing walk throughs so you can cut the number of times you need to walk a course before you feel comfortable working it. Leash runner in Masters and Advanced will wear gloves.

If you are showing in only one class, please crate in your car. Crating will be very limited and reserved for handlers who are showing in more than one class (UDX or Rally Triple Q) or more than one dog.

**Do not arrive more than an hour prior to your schedule run.** Leave immediately after your class is awarded or sooner. Masks must be worn in the building. This includes the exhibition Ring. More specific protocols will be posted at the site. No children under 13 unless showing and no spectators are invited to these trials. Thank you.

## **EXHIBITORS . . . PLEASE NOTE**

**Closing Date** for entries . . . **12 NOON, CT, Wednesday, March 10, 2021**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

**Post Dated, Returned Checks or Declined Credit Cards** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined credit or debit card.

**Entries not on an official AKC Entry Form** and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the AKC Official Entry Form are not acceptable.

**Entries received without fees** will not be accepted..

**Errors on entry blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whomever shall make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.

**No refund of duplicate entries.**

**THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.**

**Judges will not wait** for any dog holding up a class. Owners/agents are responsible for having their dogs in the judging rings when classes are called. The Show-giving Club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling/locating dogs.

**All dogs present** must be on leash or confined to their crates. Crating must be in vehicles unless multiple dogs and/or classes make car crating outside unreasonable or unless they are being judged or in the exercise ring.

**Bitches in season** (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete . . . American Kennel Club *Obedience Regulation*, amended to November 11, 2013. Females in season are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the event secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the club giving the show will return the entry fee less \$10.00 per entry to the owner of the bitch.

**Rules and regulations of civil authorities** and/or building or location restrictions will apply to all persons on the trial premises. This is a **SMOKE-FREE BUILDING**.
