Telegraph, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted.

Entries not on an official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the AKC Official Entry Form are not acceptable. **Entries received without fees** will not be accepted.

Consult judging program for time of judging.

The Show-giving Club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling/locating dogs.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates unless they are being judged or in the exercise ring.

Bitches in season (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete . . . American Kennel Club *Obedience Regulation*, amended to January 1, 2005.
