The person accompanying the dog to the show must show this identification before the dog will be received. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, excused, disqualified by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whomever shall make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.

No refund of duplicate entries.

The **Twin Ports Dog Training Club**, does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

Management is NOT responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

Consult judging program for time of judging.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/agents are responsible for having their dogs in the judging rings when classes are called. The Show-giving Club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling/locating dogs.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates unless they are being judged or in the exercise ring.

Bitches in season (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete . . . American Kennel Club *Obedience Regulation*, amended to January 1, 2005.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES less \$10.00 will be given to the entrants of bitches in these obedience and rally trials, upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trial, if received one half hour before start of all judging on the trial date.

Rules and regulations of civil authorities and/or building or location restrictions will apply to all persons on the trial premises. This is a **SMOKE-FREE BUILDING**.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. SITE & Ring Procedures—for COVID-19 Compliance.

General procedures for both Obedience and Rally. Handlers will check themselves in and pull their armbands and rubber bands. Judges will not hand out placement ribbons, you'll have to pick up your own, just like agility.

Obedience:

Novice—no posts for figure 8, big cones instead. Leash can be placed in a tote held by steward who will put it on the "go get it" chair. Stays will be the same as regulation. Judge will sanitize between dogs, (this is due to the requirement that the judge touch the dog on the stand/stay ex.)

Open—Figure 8 the same as Novice. Handler will leave their Dumbbell on a chair just outside the ring and recover it themselves. Stewards changing jumps will be assigned to a jump for the entire class and will sanitize before and after each class. Handler will deposit their leash on the "go get it chair" and later will go get it. Steward will then wipe each leash chair. Handler will pick up DB on the way out of the ring.

Utility—For articles, we will use a plastic container. Handler will place articles in the tub with gloves on top prior to entering the ring. Glove steward will use tongs or rubber gloves to handle gloves, (there will be a lot of tong use in this class). If gloves are used by Steward, Steward will sanitize between exhibitors. Article Steward will select the in use articles and place them on the in ring chair using tongs. When the article ex comes up, article Steward will place the pile using tongs. Judge will take the article on the clipboard, as usual and place in the pile. After the ex is completed, article Steward will recover the articles with tongs or gloves. Judge will sanitize between dogs for the moving stand ex. As **with** Open, Stewards will be assigned jumps to change

Rally:

Walk throughs will be limited in both number and time. Details to be determined by entry. Exhibitors, please practice doing walk throughs so you can cut the number of times you need to walk a course before you feel comfortable working it. Leash runner in Masters and Advanced will wear gloves.

Crating will be very limited and reserved for handlers who are showing more than one class (udx or Rally Triple Q) or more than one dog.

Do not arrive more than an hour prior to your schedule run. Leave immediately after your class is awarded or sooner. Masks must be worn in the building. This includes the exhibition Ring. More specific protocols will be posted at the site. No children under 13 unless showing and no spectators are invited to these trials. Thank you.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
