

SITE & Ring Procedures—for COVID-19 Compliance.

Do not arrive more than an hour prior to your schedule run. Leave immediately after your class is awarded or sooner. Masks must be worn in the building. Specific protocols will be posted at site. No children under 13 and no spectators are invited to these trials. Thank you.

The Show Site will have TWO entrances and TWO exits- labeled Entrance A AND Exit A. Entrance & Exit "A" will be located on the west (front side) of the building and will access Ring 1, the Obedience ring. Entrance B AND Exit B will access Rally Ring 2 at the rear (east) of the building. .

General procedures for both Obedience and Rally. Handlers will check themselves in and pull their armbands and rubber bands. Judges will not hand out ribbons, you'll have to pick up your own, just like agility.

If you are showing in only one class, please crate in your car. **Crating** will be very limited and reserved for handlers who are showing more than one class or more than one dog.

Ribbons will be picked up from a common table. Be sure to take an Obedience ribbons or Rally ribbon, appropriate to your sport.

Obedience:

Novice—no posts for figure 8, big cones instead. Leash can be "tossed" to steward or handed to the Judge who will put it on the go get it chair. Stays will be the same as regulation. Judge will sanitize between dogs, (this is due to the requirement that the judge touch the dog on the stand/stay ex.)

Open—Figure 8 the same as Novice. Handler will leave their Dumbbell on a chair just outside the ring and recover it themselves. Stewards changing jumps will be assigned to a jump for the entire class and will sanitize before and after each class. Handler will deposit their leash on the go get it chair and later will go get it. Steward will then wipe each lash chair. Handler will pick up DB on the way out of the ring. DB Chair will be wiped before the next DB is placed on it.

Utility—For articles, we will use a plastic container. Handler will place articles in the tub with gloves on top prior to entering the ring. Glove steward will use tongs or rubber gloves to handle gloves, (there will be a lot of tong use in this class). If gloves are used by Steward, Steward will sanitize between exhibitors. Article Steward will select the in use articles and place them on the in ring chair using tongs. When the article ex comes up, article Steward will place the pile using tongs. Judge will take the article on the clipboard, as usual and place in the pile. After the ex is completed, article Steward will recover the articles with tongs. Judge will sanitize between dogs for the moving stand ex. As with Open, Stewards will be assigned jumps to change

Rally:

Walk throughs will be limited in both number and time. Details to be determined by entry. Exhibitors, please practice doing walk throughs so you can cut the number of times you need to walk a course before you feel comfortable working it. Leash runner in Masters and Advanced will wear gloves.

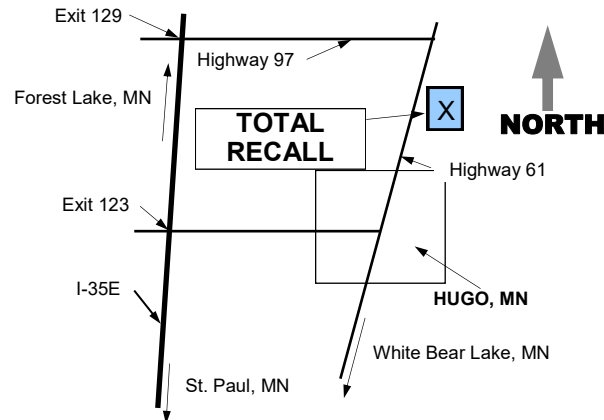
Routes To Show Site

FROM WEST (Minneapolis, MN) . . . I-35W North to I-35 North to exit 129, Hwy 97, East (right) 2 miles to Hwy 61, South (right) 3.7 miles.

RUNOFFS: Runoff for High Combined will not be performed until the completion of Utility A, Utility B and Open B and the awarding of those classes and final tabulation by the Show Secretary. Runoff for High in Trial will be performed after the awarding of all Regular Classes and final tabulation by the Show Secretary.

EXHIBITORS . . . PLEASE NOTE

POST DATED CHECKS, RETURNED CHECKS AND DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. The Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the show . . . If not, they become the property of the Show Giving Club. NO TROPHIES will be mailed.

THE SHOW SPONSORING CLUBS RESERVE THE RIGHT to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value.

MANAGEMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
