**Non-regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries:** First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Ribbons will be awarded for all four placements in the Veteran Classes. Any veteran defeated in the Veteran Classes, if entered in Best of Breed, may not compete for Best of Breed unless allowed by the judge. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in the Veteran Classes and in Veteran Sweepstakes at this independent specialty show. (*AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 8.*)

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES . . . Involving Multiple Dog Entry (NEAA Only)**

Champions of Record and altered dogs may be entered. The winners of these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

#### **Brace Class (NEAA *only*)**

For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler. Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner. Entrants need not be entered in any other class, but each must be on a separate entry form and submitted together.

#### **•Stud Dog / Brood Bitch (NEAA *only*)**

Dogs and bitches are shown with two of their offspring. Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for disqualifications or excusals. Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class. Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch; offspring are not entered on the entry form.

### **Special Events & Awards**

#### **•Best Bred-By Exhibitor Award (NEAA *only*):**

The American Kennel Club is sponsoring a special event starting this year. They are offering one free AKC Litter Registration to the Best Bred-By Exhibitor. First place from the Bred-By Exhibitor dog and bitch class will compete for this after Best of Breed competition. If the dog or bitch is Winner or Best of Winners, they will automatically be awarded Best Bred- By Exhibitor. They will be given an AKC certificate at the show

#### **•Best Feature Competition (NEAA *only*)**

Based on the Norwegian Elkhound Breed Standard, judging by selected breeders, judges, and breed mentors. All Norwegian Elkhounds (altered, veteran, rescue, etc.), at least 6 months of age, are eligible to enter competition; entry fee. Awards: Best Feature; Reserve Best Feature. A dog may be entered in one or more or all categories, each category limited entry. A dog need not be entered in a National Specialty class. Competition to be held Thursday afternoon, September 23 after the conclusion of the conformation judging.

Category: Best Coat, Best Head, Best Ears, Best Feet, Best Front, Best Tail, Best Rear.

**The Canine Good Citizen Program** is a two-part program. First: to teach responsible dog ownership to owners and second: to certify that dogs have the training and behavior needed to be reliable.

CGC tests are noncompetitive. Dogs are not required to perform items on the test with the same precision needed in formal obedience trials. The test will be held on Sunday afternoon at Animal Inn Training School. You may sign up on-line or use the all-in-one form.

#### **AKC Trick Dog Titles**

##### **• NOVICE TRICK DOG (TKN)**

The dog performs 10 skills from the Novice list. (see link to "Application" below for lists of skills). If a dog has a Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certificate or title on record at AKC, it can do 5 Novice tricks (CGC + 5) to earn the Novice title.

##### **• INTERMEDIATE TRICK DOG (TKI)**

The dog must have the Novice title, plus perform 10 Intermediate tricks.

##### **• ADVANCED TRICK DOG (TKA)**

The dog must have the Intermediate title, plus perform 5 tricks from the Advanced list.

##### **• TRICK DOG PERFORMER (TKP)**

In this title, handlers perform a short routine with at least 10 tricks previously learned.

The test will be held on Tuesday afternoon at Fairgrounds. You may sign up on-line or use the all-in-one form.

***Reserve Winner (NEAA only):***

The dog and bitch awarded Reserve Winners at only the NEAA National Specialty will be awarded a three-point major, provided the number of dogs competing in the Regular Classes of the winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the designated region for which the event is held.

***BEST OF THE BEST (NEAA only):***

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**ELIGIBILITY**

Each specialty Best of Breed winner shall be invited to attend two (2) contests with the eligibility period determined as the four (4) calendar years, defined as January 1st through December 31st, prior to the date of the Contest. Invitation replies from eligible dogs attending must be received by the Contest chairperson two (2) months prior to the Contest. The chairperson of the NEAA Best of the Best Contest shall maintain a current list of specialty show Best of Breed winners.

For any specialty club that does not have an eligible dog accepting the invitation, their corresponding secretary will be notified by email. The specialty club shall have one (1) month from that time to choose another Best of Breed winner. The specialty club may submit the name of any other dog that has been a Best of Breed winner at their specialty in other years that will accept and attend the Contest. It shall be up to each regional specialty club to decide how to determine which of their other past winners will be asked. If no substitute name is submitted, that club shall not be represented at the competition.

If an eligible dog has been the Best of Breed winner at more than one specialty show, and its participation in the Contest is confirmed, other specialty club(s) at which the eligible dog was a Best of Breed winner shall not be allowed to name an alternate Best of Breed winner as a Contest participant.

The Futurity & Maturity Premium List will be distributed only to exhibitors who have a dog eligible to compete in the Wednesday, September 22, 2021 Futurity & Maturity classes. An individually nominated dog will be eligible to compete in one Futurity and one Maturity during its lifetime. Use only the entry form provided in the Futurity & Maturity Premium List to enter a dog in this competition. The official Futurity & Maturity entry form and fees should be sent to the Show Secretary noted on the entry form. All entries close Wednesday – August 25, 2021.

### **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES (NEAA & NEAM)**

Sweepstakes is open to all Norwegian Elkhounds six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age on the date of the show. Sweepstake classes will be judged before the Regular and Non-Regular conformation classes. Sweepstakes are limited to amateur handlers and owners only. Professional handlers may handle only their own dogs

**Dogs shown in Jr & Sr Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Classes.** Sweepstakes classes will be judged separately, and there will be no further competition between the two divisions. Champions of Record whose age meets the requirements below may compete in sweepstakes. Indicate the Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes" on the entry form.
